

St Vincent's Hospital Melbourne Outpatient Referral Guidelines

What conditions do we treat?

We welcome your referral to our department. We offer patients with common or unusual skin conditions expert care and treatment. This includes (but is not limited to):

- Skin cancer
- Inflammatory skin conditions e.g. atopic dermatitis, psoriasis, rosacea, hidradenitis supprativa
- Immunobullous disease e.g. bullous pemphigoid, pemphigus vulgaris
- Connective tissue disease e.g. cutaneous lupus
- **Oral diseases** e.g. oral lichen planus
- Nail diseases
- **Urticaria**e.g. chronic spontaneous urticaria
- Autoimmune cutaneous ulcers e.g. pyoderma gangrenosum
- **Pigmentary disorders** *e.g. vitiligo*
- Infections & infestations e.g. scabies



We offer a phototherapy service and have specialised clinics in <u>Skin cancer</u>, <u>Hidradenitis Supprativa</u>, <u>Cutaneous Lymphoma</u>, <u>Photobiology</u>, <u>Pyoderma Gangrenosum</u> and Advanced Therapeutics for the treatment of <u>Atopic Dermatitis and Psoriasis</u>.

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Exclusions

Unfortunately, we do not have capacity for:

- Routine skin checks
 - Patients must have a lesion of concern examined by their GP and deemed suspicious
- Removal of benign lesions or cosmetic procedures e.g. seborrheic keratoses
- Patients under the age of 18 unless it is for a condition where Minors are not able to be seen via a Paediatric Service
- Cosmetic laser
- Uncomplicated androgenic hair loss
- Diabetic or vascular foot ulcers

- Sexually transmitted diseases
