

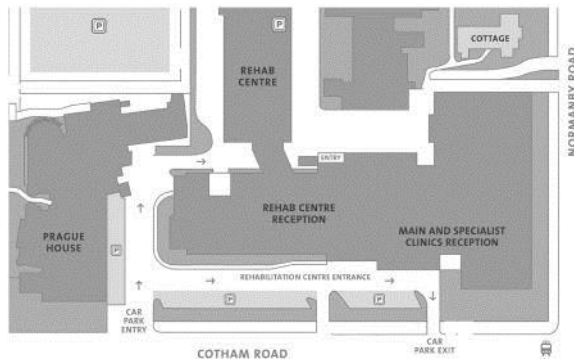

The role of our service is to help young adults with a complex physical disability, their families and carers move into adult healthcare.

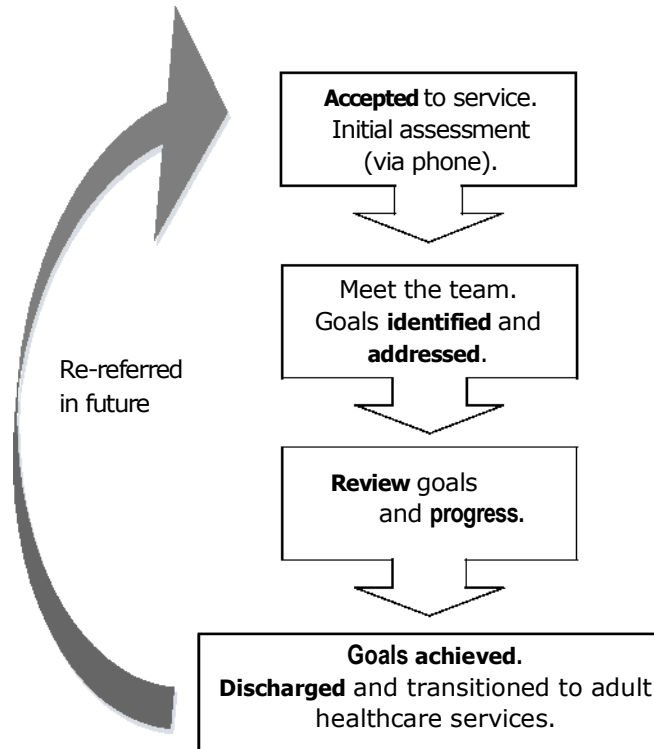
We help adults manage their own healthcare, through:

- specialist medical and allied health assessment and support
- referral to other specialist services
- goal-directed therapy
- equipment assessment and advice
- links to GPs and local therapists

Who can access the service?

Our service is available to adults with a congenital or developmental disability, resulting in complex medical and physical needs acquired before the age of 10.

Your pathway through the service



Everyone's situation is considered individually and you may re-enter the service if your needs change.
