

ST VINCENT'S COMMUNITY REHABILITATION CENTRE KEW

The centre provides rehabilitation services to people living in the City of Yarra and City of Boroondara.

The centre is run by St Vincent's Hospital Melbourne. It is based at the St George's Health Service in Kew.

What we do?

- Provide therapy to help recovery after injury, illness, surgery or other hospital stay
- Provide education to help you look after your own recovery
- Individual and group therapy sessions
- Interpreters are provided if needed

Rehabilitation programs:

- Neurological: for people with conditions such as multiple sclerosis, stroke, brain injury and Parkinson's disease.
- Musculoskeletal: for people with conditions such as joint replacement surgery, fractures, back pain and other painful conditions.
- Pulmonary and heart failure rehabilitation: for people with lung or heart disease.

Services include:

- Physiotherapy
- Occupational therapy
- Speech pathology
- Social work
- Nutrition and dietetics
- Orthotics
- Podiatry
- Psychology

How do you arrange an appointment?

You need to have a referral from a doctor or health professional.
