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WHAT IS REHABILITATION IN THE HOME?

The service provides rehabilitation in client's homes for those living in the city of Boroondara, Yarra and Darebin.

WHAT DO WE DO?

- Provide short term, goal based therapy after a hospital stay or change in ability
- Assist clients to improve their independence, and quality of life in their own home and/or local community
- Provide an interpreter at no cost

WHO IS IT FOR?

- Clients who need specific therapy in their home or community
- Home-based services are not provided to those who would benefit from therapy services in our centre. Taxis can be arranged to access the centre.

This service provides rehabilitation for clients with:

- Neurological or nervous system problems. This is for clients with conditions such as stroke, brain injury, Multiple Sclerosis or Parkinson's Disease.
- Musculoskeletal or bone, joint or muscle problems. This is for clients with conditions such as joint replacement surgery, back pain or broken bones.
- Pulmonary or heart and lung problems. This is for clients with heart or lung disease.

- occupational therapy
- physiotherapy
- speech pathology
- social work
- dietetics
