St Vincent's Cancer Centre provides state of the art facilities for cancer care and treatment to patients from across Victoria.

The Centre brings together all outpatient cancer consultations and treatment services in one accessible location.

Patients also benefit from the close collaboration of our clinical research teams and the many cancer services departments housed in the Centre.

To improve the convenience, coordination and integration of care, St Vincent's is establishing new radiotherapy and PET-CT imaging services in Fitzroy.

We have extensive outreach services in the community with medical oncology satellite clinics offered at St Vincent's Private. Werribee and Echuca.

Haematology satellite clinics also operate in Werribee, Shepparton, Roxburgh Park, Pascoe Vale. Niddrie. Wantirna and Sale.

Links to Rural and Regional Victoria

St Vincent's has a strong reputation for supporting rural and regional health services and patients. We are the largest metropolitan provider of hospital services to rural and regional Victorians with a third of our cancer patients being from non-metropolitan areas.

Continued cancer care, education and research
