1. Adam Straub Department of Addiction Medicine

Key Themes

- -Adam reported on the recently established Long Acting Injectable Buprenorphine (LAIB) clinic at St Vincent's Hospital.
- -LAIB is appropriate for anyone considering long acting opioid agonist treatment (OAT) for the management of an opioid use disorder.
- -LAIB comes in two forms in Australia, Sublocade and Buvidal and it can be injected weekly or monthly.
- -Since the coronavirus introduced social distancing and lockdown restrictions the LAIB has made it easier for some people to access treatment.
- -Many consumers have reported positive outcomes. The main benefit being people do not have to go to chemists for daily pickups or takeaways of suboxone or methadone.
- -Some consumers reported this makes it easier to get work, take holidays, leave the state, flexible time scheduling. Some consumers report improvement in mood while others report a flattened mood. One negative report is some people experience social isolation and not going out into the community.
