- Youth have sacrificed the most during the pandemic employment, education etc
- The RCVMHS did not articulate a lot about the Youth sector in the recommendations
- The Victorian Youth Strategy will be released later this year
- YACVIC will keep the sector updated
- Federal and State elections are going to impact the direction and focus of advocacy by YACVic
- Digital Literacy discussion digital services often replace F2F services in regional areas however there are many black-spot zones where service is not available and this excludes many YP. YP find phone and webchat easier than webchat often.
- Youth Peer Workforce development discussed this is an area that needs further consideration and focus, including traineeships for YP.
