SIXTEENTH ANNUAL REPORT
OF
ST. VINCENT'S HOSPITAL, MELBOURNE.

In presenting the 16th Annual Report, the Sisters of Charity again find encouragement in the knowledge that, under Divine guidance, the work at St. Vincent's Hospital continues to progress and prosper.

In the history of all institutions of the kind, there are certain years which commemorate important features of growth and development, and serve to bring into perspective the dimensions of the actual achievement, forming special points of notice for those who look back through the pages that are turned. In the history of St. Vincent's Hospital there are now three such years. The first was one which witnessed the laying of the foundation stone of the present Hospital. The second was one which saw the hospital work transferred from the small building in which it was begun into the existing Hospital, which is acknowledged to be unsurpassed by any other of its size in the world. And the year that has just closed is the third of special interest, for it has compassed the recognition of St. Vincent's Hospital as a clinical school in the University of Melbourne, and the actual admission of students to the work of the wards. Such a recognition brings the greater satisfaction that it is the highest testimony possible to the efficiency and modern equipment of the Hospital organisation.

The number of patients treated during the year shows an increase of 690 over the previous year's figures:—

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RECEIPTS.

The receipts for the year totalled £9321 10s. 2d.

EXPENDITURE.

The expenditure for the same period was £10,267 11s. 2d.

The expenditure exceeded the receipts by £946 1s.

The Maintenance Account shows an overdraft of £4887 19s. 9d.

The Building Fund.

LORD DUDLEY'S APPEAL.

The special appeal, in aid of the Building Fund, which was initiated by His Excellency Lord Dudley, Governor-General of the Commonwealth, resulted in a sum of £7260 being contributed by public subscription, and £5000 by the State Government.

The debt on the Hospital buildings and site has, by this effort, been reduced to £15,806 11s. 7d.

Clinical School.

As already mentioned, the event of the year was the formal opening of St. Vincent's Hospital Clinical School. The official function was performed by Sir John Madden, G.C.M.G., on the afternoon of March 20th, 1910, in the presence of a large and representative gathering. Addresses were delivered by Dr. Murray Morton, Chairman of the Medical Staff; Sir John Madden, Chancellor of the University; and Professor Allen, Dean of the Faculty of Medicine.

The special features of the proceedings were the unveiling of a Commemoration Tablet, the opening of the new Pathological Wing, the presentation of a "souvenir" key to Sir John Madden, and of a pendant and large picture of the new building to Mrs. John Southall. The new wing comprises a Mortuary Chapel, Pathological Laboratories, and a well-furnished Lecture-room. This handsome addition to the Hospital buildings has been made possible chiefly by the munificent gift of Mrs. Southall, and will be known as the "Southall Wing."

Monthly Shilling Fund.

MEMBERS OF THE LEAGUE OF HELP.

The members of the League of Help, who have interested themselves with such good result in this movement, are asked to continue their efforts, and endeavour to obtain new workers. By this means the Sisters of Charity hope to be enabled to meet interest charges in the Building Fund. The amount received since the League of Help was established in 1907 is £3583 15s.—an average of £1050 for each year—and it is confidently hoped that next year will show a still larger total.

A Last Word.

The present is a time of great prosperity throughout the State of Victoria and the Commonwealth of Australia. It is at such a time that the thought of making better provision for the suffering and unfortunate must appeal with greatest force, and should meet with the most ready response. The existing accommodation at St. Vincent's Hospital is quite insufficient to meet the ever-growing demands upon its general and special work. Deserving cases have almost daily to be denied admission, for the only reason that such a demand is ever denied—namely, want of beds.

There still remains a considerable debt upon the present building, and the Sisters of Charity, while fully recognising and gratefully acknowledging the generosity of subscribers in the past, earnestly ask, in the present prosperous seasons, something may be set apart to assist them in their efforts to care for the sick and injured. The ideal of a great Hospital standing free of debt is one within reach of attainment. More subscribers are urgently needed in order to keep pace with the always anxious problem of maintenance. A wider circle of friends is wanted to enable the Sisters of Charity to undertake with confidence the completion of the original Hospital design, which would mean an additional hundred beds in occupation, and bring comfort to many a sufferer for whom it is now impossible to find a place.

If there be any who think that further hospital accommodation is not required, or if there be others who have not given the matter thought at all, the Sisters of Charity would only ask that such doubts should be dispelled by a visit to the Hospital, where the volume of work is open for anyone to see and realise for themselves. There is need for continued help of every degree, and for new help of every dimension. Every great building is made up of foundation and superstructure. It is not within the power of all to put in foundation stones, but everyone can, if they will, add a brick to the walls which are devoted to the shelter of suffering humanity. What more fitting memorial of a time of plenty than a great hospital completed and out of debt!

Though often drawn upon, true generosity and good-will can never be exhausted. Though much has been done in the past, there is still—
