# Handy hints for applying to St Vincent's Hospital Melbourne

## **WORKDAY**

To apply for a role, search the position via Workday on our 'SVHA Find Jobs' page https://svha.wd3.myworkdayjobs.com/en-US/SVHA\_SVHM

- Many positions are also advertised on external job sites including Seek.
- Submit your Cover Letter, CV and any other documents all together.
- If you miss attaching anything and are unable to go back or re-login to resubmit, please send these to **JMSRecruitment@svha.org.au** and we can upload these for you.
- For any positions entering a PMCV match (eg. Internship), late applications cannot be accepted.

## **COVER LETTER**

- Address your cover letter to the correct contact person; this shows you have read the advertisement and done your research well.
- Ensure you have addressed it to the correct hospital.
- Limit your cover letter to 1 page (400 words) in length, addressing:
  - How you will add value to the team at SVHM
  - Why you are passionate about working for SVHM
  - What makes you stand out.

## CV

- For any positions entering a PMCV match (eg. Internship), please use the PMCV template for your CV.
- Keep your CV to 4 pages maximum.
- Use a clear font that is easy to read.
- Include your extracurricular activities and achievements that make your CV stand out.

## **INTERVIEW**

It is likely that interviews will need to be conducted remotely via an online platform i.e. Microsoft Teams. Some helpful hints for interviewing virtually include:

- Ensure your technology is working prior to your interview; this includes camera, microphone, speakers and Wi-Fi connection.
- Get to know how to navigate the online platform prior to your interview.
- A quiet, well-lit environment with a neutral background is advised.
- Dress professionally, just as you would in-person.
- Be ready for your interview at least 5 minutes prior the scheduled start time.
- Be aware of your voice speed, volume, pronunciation and body language.
- Look at the camera during your interview; think of it as making eye contact with your interview panel.
