This book is about our **Access and Inclusion Plan**.




We call it the plan.

• get the support they need.


What we think about disability

staff




patients



• families and carers.




People gave us many ideas on what we can do better.

What we want to change




We are **committed** to making our hospital better for people with disability.

We want to get better for many different people with disability including






• First Nations people with disability

how we hire staff




how we can know someone has a disability

We will ask people with disability to tell us what should change.






From July 2025 everything we do should work well for people with disability.


2 We will work together

Advisory committees are groups of people that help us make decisions.


3 We will make our hospital more accessible
