Most likely to require follow up

- Moderate or Severe COVID 19 symptoms experienced

- Prolonged hospital stay or ICU stay +/- ventilator

- Post Intensive Care Syndrome (PICS) or Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome (ARDS) during admission

If still experiencing the following, please refer on to Community Rehabilitation Services	
Symptoms	Changes to usual activities
- Fatigue and loss of endurance	- Vocational activities e.g. work
- Mobility concerns, including balance and falls	- Leisure activities e.g. gardening, reading
- Loss of weight or poor intake	- Community activities e.g. shopping, driving
- Ongoing pain or painful abnormal sensations	<ul> <li>Household and domestic activities e.g. cooking, housework, repairs</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Issues with bladder or bowel control</li> <li>Changes to memory, planning and thinking</li> </ul>	- Washing, dressing or using toilet
- Mood concerns	- Mobility around the house and in the community
- Swallowing or speech issues	<ul> <li>Social interaction with others – talking, taking part in conversations</li> </ul>
